Who is responsible for killing of prophets? Was it the Jews, Jezebel or Baal? Jesus in Revelation 18:24 says in the harlot great city “was found the blood of prophets.”

THE REVELATION HARLOT

There is a strong Biblical prophetic connection between Jezebel (1 Kings 16:29-34) and the warnings Jesus gave about the “great city”, the spiritual harlot, in the book of Revelation (chapters 17 and 18). Baal (the beast) is involved with both. Baal’s home today, the Kaaba in Mecca, is the spiritual harlot great city in the desert wilderness as foretold in Revelation.

JESUS REBUKES THE PHARISEES ABOUT BAAL--“BEELZEBUL”

The woes of the Pharisees are a list of criticisms by Jesus against Scribes and Pharisees recorded in the Gospels of Luke 11:37–54, Matthew 23:1–39, Mark 12:35–40 and Luke 20:45–47. One of the woes is that the ancestors of the Pharisees killed the prophets as described in First and Second Kings with Ahab, Baal and Jezebel.

Matthew 23:29-32 (NIV)

“Woe to you, teachers of the law and Pharisees, you hypocrites! You build tombs for the prophets and decorate the graves of the righteous. And you say, ‘If we had lived in the days of our ancestors, we would not have taken part with them in shedding the blood of the prophets.’ So you testify against yourselves that you are the descendants of those who murdered the prophets. Go ahead, then, and complete what your ancestors started!

We know from First and Second Kings it was Baal who influenced the ancestors of the Pharisees to kill the prophets. Those that killed the prophets, people like Ahab and Jezebel, were under demonic control. Baal truly is the “prince of demons.”

As the Son of God, Jesus has complete authority over all demons, including Baal. Jesus cast out demons in front of the Pharisees. After seeing this miracle, the Pharisees blasphemed the Holy Spirit and accused Jesus of working with Baal, whom they called “Beelzebul.” Jesus said whoever blasphemes the Holy Spirit will not be forgiven.

Mark 3:22 (NIV)

And the teachers of the law who came down from Jerusalem said, “He is possessed by Beelzebul! By the prince of demons he is driving out demons.”

Mark 3:28-29 (NIV)

“Truly I tell you, people can be forgiven all their sins and every slander they utter, but whoever blasphemes against the Holy Spirit will never be forgiven; they are guilty of an eternal sin.”

The Pharisees not only blasphemed God’s Spirit as “Beelzebul”, the prince of the demons, but they condemned God’s work. They condemned and blasphemed the Lord Jesus Christ. The essence of their resistance and blasphemy of God was entirely the same as the essence of Satan and Baal’s (the Revelation dragon and beast) resistance and blasphemy of God. They not only represented corrupt humans, but they were a channel for Satan and Baal into all mankind, and they were the accomplices and messengers of Satan. The essence of their blasphemy and their denigration of the Lord Jesus Christ was their struggle with God for status, their contest with God, their unending testing of God.

BEELZEBUL MEANS “LORD OF THE FLIES”

Why did the Pharisees speak of Beelzebul with such familiarity? Beelzebul or Beelzebub, Hebrew: בַּעַל זְבוּב Ba'al Zəvûv, (literally “Lord of the Flies”) is a name derived from the Canaanite-Philistine god Baal, worshipped in Ekron, and later mentioned many times in the Bible as a major demon. This same spirit Baal is the beast of Revelation released from the Abyss by Satan sometime after John was given the Revelation IN 95 AD.

The name Beelzebul is associated with the Canaanite god Baal. We know that Jesus and the Pharisees recognized Beelzebul and referred to him as the “prince of demons.” But why is Beelzebul also called the “Lord of the Flies”? Archaeologists can now give us the answer.

Matthew 12:22-28 (NIV)

Then they brought him a demon-possessed man who was blind and mute, and Jesus healed him, so that he could both talk and see. All the people were astonished and said, “Could this be the Son of David?” But when the Pharisees heard this, they said, “It is only by Beelzebul, the prince of demons, that this fellow drives out demons.” Jesus knew their thoughts and said to them, “Every kingdom divided against itself will be ruined, and every city or household divided against itself will not stand. If Satan drives out Satan, he is divided against himself. How then can his kingdom stand? And if I drive out demons by Beelzebul, by whom do your people drive them out?”



THE 3,000 YEAR OLD TOILET IN THE HOUSE OF BAAL

“THEY DEMOLISHED THE SACRED STONE OF BAAL AND TORE DOWN THE TEMPLE OF BAAL, AND PEOPLE HAVE USED IT FOR A LATRINE TO THIS DAY.”

Archaeologists have discovered a symbolic toilet from the eighth century BC in Jerusalem is a clue to religious reforms in the Kingdom of Judah.

The stone toilet sits in Tel Lachish, a sprawling Iron Age city and the Kingdom of Judah's most important one after the capitol, Jerusalem. It was found in what the archaeologists believe to be a gate-shrine within Israel's largest ancient city gate. The Northern ruler at that time, King Jehu, enacted campaigns of religious worship and reform that made their way into the Hebrew Bible on multiple occasions.

In one corner of the shrine sits a stone seat with a hole in the center. The archaeologists believe that not only is it definitely a toilet, it's a toilet that was installed for the express purpose of literally desecrating the shrine of Baal.

2 Kings 10:20-27 (NIV)

Jehu said, “Call an assembly in honor of Baal.”

So they proclaimed it. Then he sent word

throughout Israel, and all the servants of Baal came; not one stayed away. They crowded into the temple of Baal until it was full from one end to the other. And Jehu said to the keeper of the wardrobe, “Bring robes for all the servants of Baal.” So he brought out robes for them.

Then Jehu and Jehonadab son of Rekab went into the temple of Baal. Jehu said to the servants of Baal, “Look around and see that no one who serves the Lord is here with you—only servants of Baal.” So they went in to make sacrifices and burnt offerings. Now Jehu had posted eighty men outside with this warning: “If one of you lets any of the men I am placing in your hands escape, it will be your life for his life.”

As soon as Jehu had finished making the burnt offering, he ordered the guards and officers: “Go in and kill them; let no one escape.” So they cut them down with the sword. The guards and officers threw the bodies out and then entered the inner shrine of the temple of Baal. They brought the sacred stone out of the temple of Baal and burned it. They demolished the sacred stone of Baal and tore down the temple of Baal, and people have used it for a latrine to this day.



JEZEBEL BRINGS BAAL AND KILLS GOD'S PROPHETS

Jezebel rebelled against God and brought Baal worship to Israel. Satan rebelled against God and released Baal out of the Abyss to worldwide worship. Jezebel's father was Ethbaal. Ethbaal means ***“Baal is with him.”*** Jezebel means ***“looking for the Prince Bel [Baal].”*** Jezebel was a harlot woman. Jezebel delivers (spiritual) sexual immorality.



ETHBAAL LIKENESS—IT MEANS “BAAL IS WITH HIM”

When the king Omri died, Ahab his son, became the next king of Northern Israel. Ahab married Jezebel, and Jezebel brought widespread Baal worship to Israel. Jezebel was a murderer and a prophetess. Jesus warned about Jezebel also in Revelation chapter 2.

1 Kings 16:29-33 (NIV)

In the thirty-eighth year of Asa king of Judah, Ahab son of Omri became king of Israel, and he reigned in Samaria over Israel twenty-two years. Ahab son of Omri did more evil in the eyes of the Lord than any of those before him. He not only considered it trivial to commit the sins of Jeroboam son of Nebat, but he also married Jezebel daughter of Ethbaal king of the Sidonians, and began to serve Baal and worship him. He set up an altar for Baal in the temple of Baal that he built in Samaria. Ahab also made an Asherah pole and did more to arouse the anger of the Lord, the God of Israel, than did all the kings of Israel before him.

JEZEBEL KILLS GOD'S PROPHETS ON BEHALF OF BAAL

Jesus warns against Jezebel and false prophecy in Revelation 2:20. In Jeremiah 23:13 we learn that Baal is the source of false prophecy given to Israelites. Jezebel relied upon Baal for prophecy. So did many Israelites.

Revelation 2:20 (NIV)

Nevertheless, I have this against you: You tolerate that woman Jezebel, who calls herself a prophet. By her teaching she misleads my servants into sexual immorality and the eating of food sacrificed to idols.

Jeremiah 23:13 (NIV)

Among the prophets of Samaria I saw this repulsive thing: They prophesied by Baal and led my people Israel astray.

Jezebel persuaded her husband to promote the worship of Baal in Samaria to the people of Israel. Since Jezebel was Phoenician, she more than likely had a role that was more active than what was normal in Hebrew rule. Jezebel required the installation of a temple and an altar for Baal, which was built in Samaria. Baal then killed God's prophets.

1 Kings 18:3-4 (NIV)

Ahab had summoned Obadiah, his palace administrator. (Obadiah was a devout believer in the Lord. While Jezebel was killing off the Lord's prophets, Obadiah had taken a hundred prophets and hidden them in two caves, fifty in each, and had supplied them with food and water.)

Baal wants to be God but is not. Baal cannot bring fire down from heaven, but God does on Mount Carmel. Elijah shows that Baal is not God, and greatly angers Jezebel.

1 Kings 18:36-38 (NIV)

At the time of sacrifice, the prophet Elijah stepped forward and prayed: "Lord, the God of Abraham, Isaac and Israel, let it be known today that you are God in Israel and that I am your servant and have done all these things at your command. Answer me, Lord, answer me, so these people will know that you, Lord, are God, and that you are turning their hearts back again." Then the fire of the Lord fell and burned up the sacrifice, the wood, the stones and the soil, and also licked up the water in the trench.

1 Kings 19:1-2 (NIV)

Now Ahab told Jezebel everything Elijah had done and how he had killed all the prophets with the sword. So Jezebel sent a messenger to Elijah to say, "May the gods deal with me, be it ever so severely, if by this time tomorrow I do not make your life like that of one of them."

BAAL GIVES A DECEPTION OF “FIRE FROM HEAVEN” FOR MOHAMMAD



And it performed great signs, even causing fire to come down from heaven to the earth in full view of the people.

Revelation 13:13 (NIV)

In the Qur'an Allah (Baal) creates a deception convincing bystanders that “*Allah is able to send down a sign*”, meaning fire from heaven for doubters of the false prophet Mohammad. This fulfills Revelation prophecy about the false prophet and his great signs. We know from the story of Elijah that only God can bring down fire from heaven.

Revelation 13:13-14 (NIV)

And it performed great signs, even causing fire to come down from heaven to the earth in full view of the people. Because of the signs it was given power to perform on behalf of the first beast, it deceived the inhabitants of the earth. It ordered them to set up an image in honor of the beast who was wounded by the sword and yet lived.

Qur'an 3:183 They are those [Jews] who said, "Indeed, Allah has taken our promise not to believe any messenger until he **brings us an offering which fire from heaven will consume.**"
Mohammad say: "There have already come to you messengers before me with clear proofs and even that of which you speak. So why did you kill them, if you should be truthful?"

Qur'an 6:37 And they say, "Why has a sign not been sent down to him from his Lord?"
Mohammad Say: **"Indeed, Allah is able to send down a sign, but most of them do not know."**

HOW DOES ALLAH OF THE QUR'AN KNOW THE PROPHETS WERE KILLED?

All Muslim scholars insist that Mohammad did not use the Bible to produce the Qur'an. Mohammad could not read or write, and only memorized and later recited the verses given to him from the spirit—calling himself the “Angel Gabriel”—but it was really Baal released from the Abyss. The spirit giving verses to Mohammad was quite sure the true prophets of God were killed. Allah acknowledges the prophets were killed repeatedly in **nine passages** in the Qur'an. How does the spirit know this fact so well? Why does Allah always blame the Jews?

The answer is that the true author of the Qur'an, Baal, calling himself Allah, killed all of God's prophets. We know this for certain from Revelation 18:24.

Qur'an 5:70 We made a covenant with the Israelites and sent Messengers to them. **Whenever a Messenger came to them with a message which did not suit their desires, they would reject some of the Messengers and kill others.**

Qur'an 3:181 Allah has certainly heard the statement of those Jews who said, “Indeed, Allah is poor, while we are rich.” **We will record what they said and their killing of the prophets without right and will say, "Taste the punishment of the Burning Fire."**

Qur'an 3:183 They are those [Jews] who said, "Indeed, Allah has taken our promise not to believe any messenger until he brings us an offering which fire from heaven will consume." Mohammad say: "There have already come to you messengers before me with clear proofs and even that of which you speak. **So why did you kill them, if you should be truthful?"**

Qur'an 4:155 **And we cursed them for their breaking of the covenant and their disbelief in the signs of Allah and their killing of the prophets without right** and their saying, "Our hearts are wrapped". Rather, Allah has sealed them because of their disbelief, so they believe not, except for a few.

Qur'an 2:91 And when it is said to them, "Believe in what Allah has revealed," they say, "We believe only in what was revealed to us." And they disbelieve in what came after it, while it is the truth confirming that which is with them. Say, **"Then why did you kill the prophets of Allah before, if you are indeed believers?"**

Qur'an 2:61 (b) That was because **they repeatedly disbelieved in the signs of Allah and killed the prophets without right.** That was because they disobeyed and were always transgressing.

Qur'an 2:87 And indeed, We gave Moses the Book and followed him up with a succession of Messengers. And We gave Jesus, the son of Mary, clear signs and supported him with Gabriel. Is it that whenever there came to you a Messenger with what you yourselves desired not, you grew arrogant? **Some, you disbelieved and some, you killed.**

Qur'an 3:21 **Those who disbelieve in the signs of Allah and kill the prophets without right** and kill those who order justice from among the people - give them tidings of a painful punishment.

Qur'an 3:112 They have been put under humiliation by Allah wherever they are overtaken, except for a covenant from Allah and a rope from the Muslims. And they have drawn upon themselves anger from Allah and have been put under destitution. **That is because they disbelieved in the verses of Allah and killed the prophets without right.** That is because they disobeyed and habitually transgressed.

JESUS TELLS US THE SPIRIT THAT RESIDES IN THE “GREAT CITY” HAS KILLED ALL THE PROPHETS



Revelation chapter 17 and 18 deal with the harlot “great city” that “rules over the kings of the earth” in the “desert wilderness.” It “sits on seven mountains.” There is only one city in the world that meets all these criteria--which is Mecca. Baal, the beast of Revelation, dwells in the Kaaba in Mecca. The reason the spirit that gave the Qur'an knows that all the prophets had been killed is because that spirit is Baal who killed the prophets. This city is the haunt for all demons including the “prince of demons.”

This is the same beast, from the Abyss, that kills the two witnesses (Michael and Gabriel).

Revelation 11:7 (NIV)

Now when they have finished their testimony, the beast that comes up from the Abyss will attack them, and overpower and kill them.

Revelation 18:1-3 (NIV)

After this I saw another angel coming down from heaven. He had great authority, and the earth was illuminated by his splendor. With a mighty voice he shouted:

“Fallen! Fallen is Babylon the Great!’ She has become a dwelling for demons and a haunt for every impure spirit, a haunt for every unclean bird, a haunt for every unclean and detestable animal. For all the nations have drunk the maddening wine of her adulteries. The kings of the earth committed adultery with her, and the merchants of the earth grew rich from her excessive luxuries.”

Revelation 18:24 (NIV)

In her was found the blood of prophets and of God’s holy people, of all who have been slaughtered on the earth.”

The universal symbol of Baal is the crescent moon. This is why in Revelation 12 the woman giving birth to Jesus has the moon under her feet. Baal is inferior to Jesus Christ.
